Swift Building Services (Midlands) Ltd is committed to achieving Net Zero emissions by 2050.

Baseline Emissions Footprint

Baseline emissions are a record of the greenhouse gases that have been produced in the past and were produced prior to the introduction of any strategies to reduce emissions. Baseline emissions are the reference point against which emissions reduction can be measured.

Since we have not previously assessed or reported emissions, the first reporting period starting from 1 July 2024 will be used as our baseline.

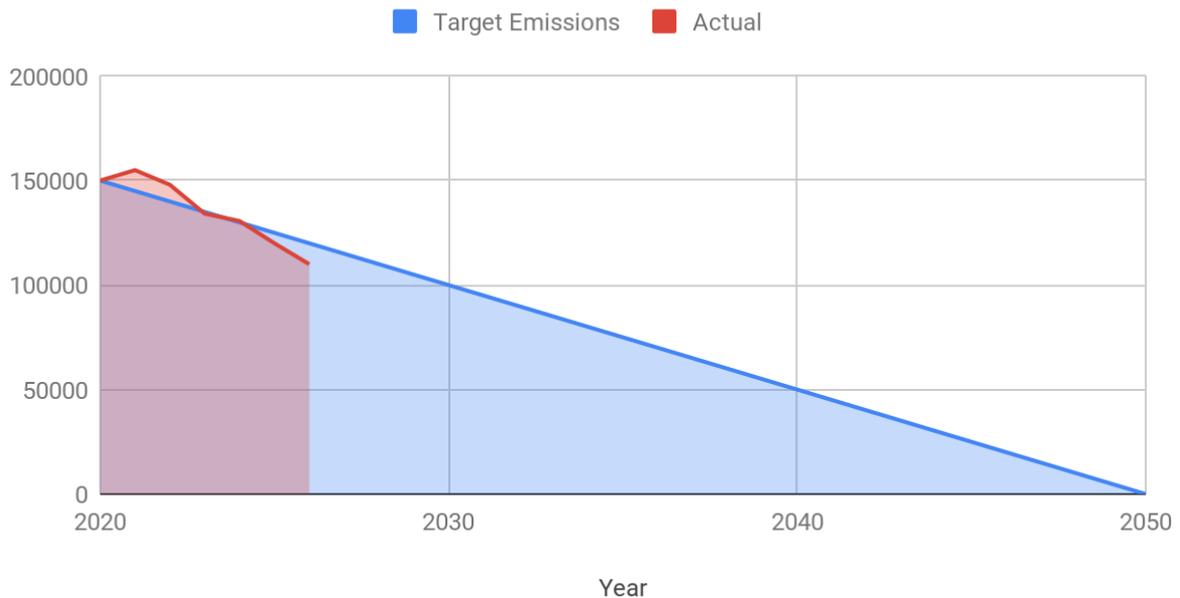
Emissions reduction targets

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

As this is our first carbon footprint recording, we are committed to the following reduction targets: We project that our carbon emissions will decrease by 25% over the next five years, aiming for a total of 60% tCO₂e by 2029.

Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented since the 2024 baseline. The carbon emission reduction achieved by these schemes equate to 0 tCO₂e, a 0 %ge reduction against the 2024 baseline and the measures will be in effect when performing the contract are itemised below:

Since we are starting our baseline measurement in 2024, no previous carbon reduction initiatives have been recorded. Future projects will be documented and reported in subsequent years.
